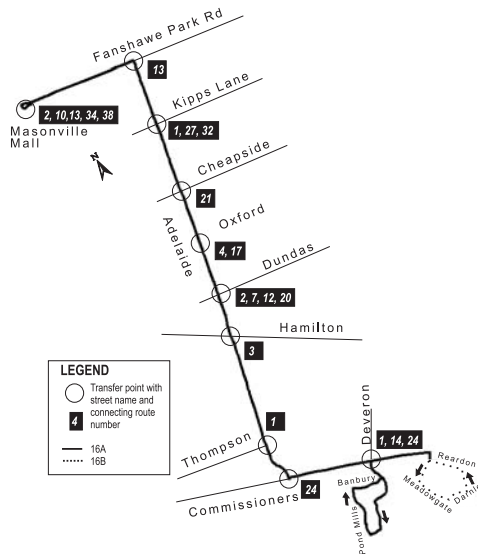

SPECIAL INFORMATION FOR ACCESSIBLE SERVICE
 Routes designated as accessible means that every scheduled bus on the route will be a low-floor accessible bus. However, some stop locations may not be fully accessible at this time.
Passengers should be aware of the following service characteristics:
Accessible Transit is not a replacement for Paratransit nor can space be reserved.
 Passengers must be able to get themselves to and from the bus stop.
 Crowded buses can occur in 'rush hours', from 7:00-9:00am and 2:30-5:30pm Monday to Friday.
 During rush hours 'Tripper' buses may run between and in addition to, regularly scheduled buses and may not be accessible low-floor buses.
 Occasionally mechanical problems may require temporarily replacing a bus with a non low-floor bus. This may mean a minor disruption of service.
 Low-floor buses have a maximum of two scooter/wheelchair securement areas.
